Do you have an immigration question? Do you need help with an application?

Come to the Reception desk to schedule a 15-minute appointment. Please bring your immigration document with you. We'll check your eligibility and explain everything that you'll need for your next appointment, when we'll do your application.

Please note that we can only assist refugees, asylees, permanent residents (green card holders), and naturalized citizens.

PASSPORT PHOTOS are available Monday -- Friday from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. No appointment needed.
